

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Final Report

Scientific works are generally the result of work obtained from writing activities to solve a problem by applying scientific conventions. Usually, scientific papers contain data, facts, and solutions regarding a topic being discussed. Scientific writing is carried out in a coherent and systematic manner. According to Nurfitirani et al. (2019), “scientific paper is an essay that present opinions, observations, reviews, and research in certain fields which are compiled according to certain methods with systematic writing, polite language, and content whose truth can be accounted for” (p. 7).

Based on the description above, it can be concluded that scientific paper is the result of an essay that contains data and facts in certain fields that are arranged systematically and can be accounted for. In writing scientific papers, writers need many sources of information and reference sources in writing. The available reference sources must of course be accurate and based on facts.

Giltrud (2021) states about reference source.

Reference sources include dictionaries, encyclopedias, thesauri, directories, and other materials providing general information about a variety of subjects. When you need the "backstory" on a subject, reference sources are the main source for who, what, when, where and why questions. Search the library catalog or the reference section of the library databases to find and locate resources for you writing assignment.

In general, a reference is information that can be used as a reference or source of reference to confirm a statement submitted. According to Putra and Irawati (2018), "reference service is an important service owned by the library that serves to facilitate users in terms of searching or retrieval of information according to their needs." (p. 78), and also according to Maharini (2018), "references are relational markers that connect words to the object or thing they refer to." (p. 3). Whereas according to Djajasudarma (2010), "references are used to emphasize that a topic that appears to be new is actually an old topic." (p. 39).

Based on the description above, it can be concluded that reference sources are pre-existing information that can be used as a reference to emphasize new topics to be discussed and can be found in libraries and other sources. One source of reference is E-Journal which provides scientific and academic articles on various topics.

To provide reference sources and sources of information as well as reading resources, the English Diploma Program provides an E-Journal platform through the EnJourMe (English Journal of Merdeka) portal which provides various online articles. EnJourMe Portal is a portal that makes it easy for students to access

various types of online articles owned by the English D3 Program. The EnJourMe portal provides online articles in the fields of culture, language and English language teaching.

The English D3 Program E-Journal is a collection of articles that have been pre-screened and then uploaded to the EnJourMe portal by the English D3 Program.
